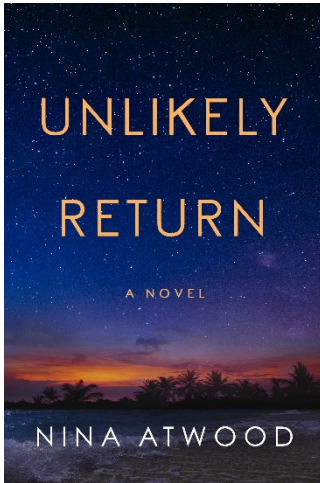


Unlikely Return: A Novel

Have you ever experienced anything similar to the relationship issues of the couples? What did you feel about that as you read the book?

How did you feel about Tony? Did you lean more toward contempt or compassion for him? Why?

Which couples' relationship resonated the most for you, and why?

What major relationship "truths" did the story tell or highlight?

Did the book alter your perception about relationships in any way? How?

What quotes, passages, or scenes did you find particularly compelling?

What parts of the book did you think were unique, thought-provoking, or disturbing?

How did you feel about the end? Were you satisfied? Dissatisfied?

How do you picture the characters' lives after the end of the story?
